A crisp entry leads to flavors of candied grapefruit, and glazed pineapple, with just a hint of key lime. The mid-palate is rich and ever present finishing with a tangy and lingering acidity.

Aromas of pineapple, tropical flavors, and lime zest. On the mouth, lemon chiffon, and crème Brule, with a lift of fresh baked bread filling out the broad palate.

2006 Oliver Leflaive, Le Deux Rives, Chablis

50

The vines from which this wine comes from are more than thirty years old, blended from vineyards on both sides of the Serein River. Les Deux Rives is a true expression of Chablis terrior. Citrus zest and pear on the nose lead to racing acidity and notes of pear, mango, and minerality on the palate. The finish is lengthy, yet clean.

2006 August Briggs, Carneros

55

Tropical fruit aromas mingle with melon and vanilla on the nose. This Chardonnay has medium weight on the palate with tropical flavors of passion fruit and pineapple, and citrus flavors of mandarin orange and key lime, with a hint of soft oak.

2007 Gary Ferrell, Russian River Selection

55

This Chardonnay has bright aromas of lemon custard and butterscotch. The palate is massive with flavors of grilled pineapple and green apples. The finish is lingering with smooth acidity and flavors of nutmeg and toast.
